**Lofoten Islands:** Famous for their dramatic scenery, fishing villages, and outdoor activities.





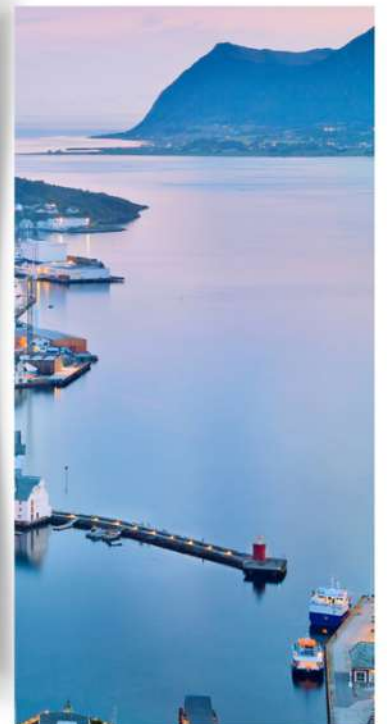
## Best Time to Visit

Autumn (September to October): Beautiful fall colors, with fewer tourists.

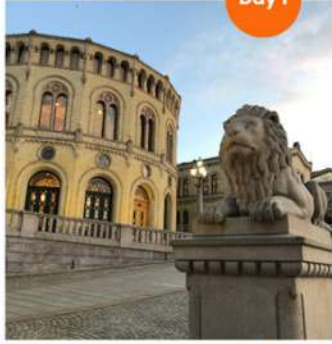
Winter (November to March): Perfect for winter sports, Northern Lights, and a cozy atmosphere.

# 8 Day Sample Itinerary of Norway

## Day 1



**Arrive in Oslo**  
Morning: Arrive in Oslo and check into your hotel.  
Afternoon: Explore the Vigeland Sculpture Park in Frogner Park and visit the Oslo Opera House for panoramic views of the city.  
Evening: Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant, sampling traditional Norwegian cuisine.

Afternoon: Visit Tromsø Arctic-Alpine Botanic Garden or take a dog sledding or reindeer sledding tour, depending on the season.  
Evening: Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant and, if conditions permit, venture out to see the Northern Lights.

## Day 8



**Departure from Tromsø**  
Morning: Spend your last morning in Tromsø exploring any remaining sights or shopping for souvenirs.
