



Best Time to Visit

8 Day Sample Itinerary of Norway



Arrive in Oslo
Morning: Arrive in Oslo and check into
your hotel.

, Afternoon: Explore the Vigeland Sculpture Park in Frogner Park and visit the Oslo Opera House for panoramic views of the city.

Evening: Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant, sampling traditional Norwegian cuisine.



Oslo Sightseeing Morning: Visit the Akershus Fortress and take a stroll along the waterfront. Afternoon: Explore the Nobel Peace Center and the Viking Ship Museum on Bygdøy Peninsula.

Oslo to Bergen

Morning: Take the scenic train ride from Oslo to Bergen (approximately 6.5 hours). The journey is known for its stunning landscapes.

Bergen to Geirangerfjord

Afternoon: Arrive at Geirangerfjord and take a fjord cruise to experience the stunning scenery, including waterfalls like the Seven Sisters.

Evening: Check into accommodation in the Geiranger area and enjoy dinner with a view.



Geirangerfjord to Ålesund Morning: Drive or take a bus to Ålesund (approximately 2 hours), known for its Art Nouveau grchitecture.

Afternoon: Explore the town and visit Aksla viewpoint for panoramic views of Ålesund and the surrounding islands. Evening: Enjoy dinner at a local seafood restaurant, sampling fresh fish dishes.



Ålesund to Tromsø

Morning: Fly from Ålesund to Tromsø (approximately 1.5 hours).
Afternoon: Arrive in Tromsø and check into your hotel. Visit the Polar Museum to learn about Arctic history.

Evening: If visiting in winter, consider a Northern Lights tour or simply explore the charming city center.



Tromsø Exploration

Morning: Take a cable car ride up Mount Storsteinen for stunning views of Tromsø and the surrounding fjords.

Afternoon: Visit Tromsø Arctic-Alpine Botanic Garden or take a dog sledding or reindeer sledding tour, depending on the season.

Evening: Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant and, if conditions permit, venture out to see the Northern Lights.
