Day 1



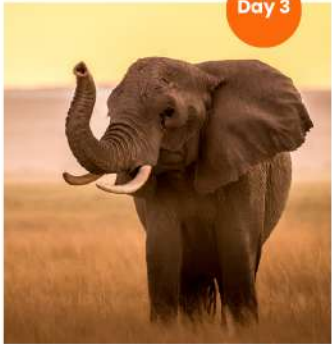
Arrival in Nairobi

Day 2



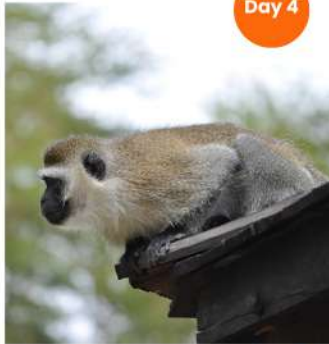
Nairobi National Park & Kazuri Beads

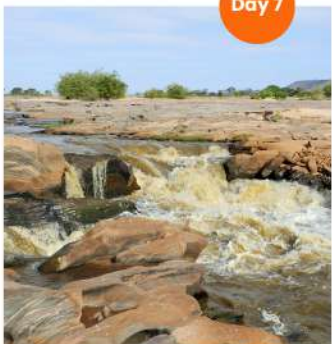
Transfer to Tsavo West National Park

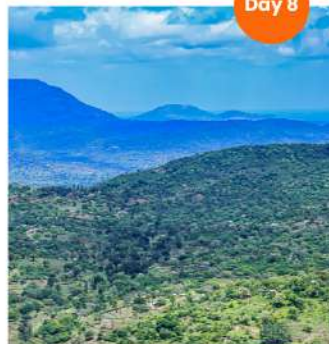

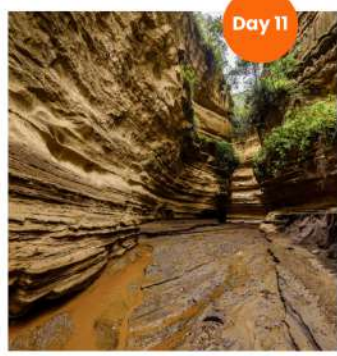

 Relax by the lake or visit nearby geothermal spa.



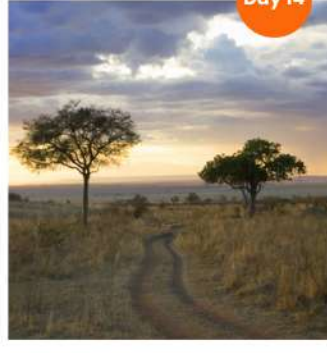
